

Notice on Foreign Student Scholarship Application (Fall 2024)

1. Eligibility

- Foreign graduate school students who will register for their regular semester in the Fall 2024.
- * Students who will register for their additional semester for credit earning, research semester or who will supposed to have a leave of absence as of 2024 fall semester **are not eligible**.
- * GKS scholars and joint/dual degree students **are not eligible**.
- All requirements(please refer to the '2. Requirements') for application should be met.
- Students should apply for the scholarship every semester.

- **Requirement I: GPA for 2024 Spring semester (To be announced in July 2024)**
 - * If GPA doesn't meet the requirements, the application will be cancelled automatically.
 - * The GPA is not confirmed as of the application period, students can apply one or more type scholarships.(However, the students can receive only one type of scholarships.)
- **Requirement II: Completion of Compulsory Education for Foreign Students**
(①Sexual Violence Prevention Education and ②Understanding Korean Laws and Regulations Education)
 - * From Fall 2023, only those students who already complete to take compulsory courses can apply for the scholarships.
 - * Please check the attached files for how-to sign up the courses and how-to get a certificate of completion.
